

How Long will Credit Repair Take to Increase My Credit Score?

Your credit dispute letters must be delivered by mail, and the credit bureaus that receive the disputes are granted up to 30 days to respond — 45 if the reports used were obtained for "free" online.

Each credit bureau (CRA) has 30 to 45 days by law to conduct an investigation for a given credit dispute letter. We know results are important to you, so we get the process started immediately to make your credit disputes move out as often as possible.

The key is to keep new negative data from appearing on your credit reports during the credit repair process. Provided there are no new negatives, your credit reports and score should gradually improve as successive rounds of credit dispute letters are sent out.
